WHY "CONEXAO"?

Conexao is the Portuguese word for "**Connection**."

Many immigrants arrive in a new country feeling disconnected, overwhelmed, and uncertain where they belong. Our desire is to help them experience authentic Christian community because **no one was made to walk alone**.

More importantly, we want every person to discover the greatest connection of all: a restored relationship with God through Jesus Christ. Conexao is being planted in Winter Garden, where a growing Brazilian community has settled.

A PROMISING BEGINNING

Our family arrived in Central Florida on July 3 to begin planting Conexao. On July 5, we gathered for the first time with families who have already begun walking alongside us. It was a joyful reminder that God is already preparing people before a church even exists. In August, we will launch our Core Group Meetings, where we'll share the vision, mission, and values of Conexao.
